 - B. Mr. Dwight Darling from 965 Greenville Avenue would like to speak about the new Citizens bank building being built in Johnston. He also would like to discuss the possibility of increased traffic on Greenville Ave. as a result of the new on/off ramps from Rte 295 to Greenville Ave. in Johnston. He would like to restrict commercial vehicles from operating on Greenville Avenue from Sanderson Rd. to Putnam Pike. He also would like to know if there are any contingency plans for increased traffic on Greenville Ave and Putnam Pike as he believes traffic will be increased tenfold. He was advised that the construction is taking place in Johnston and is a State project on State highways and we do not have jurisdiction to make any decisions about it. He would like to address future traffic problems that will occur because of the project in Johnston, RI.
