C. Request from Town Manager Finlay to post "No Overnight Parking" signs at Esmond Park.

V. Old Business

1. Turtle Crossing signs have been ordered. They are 30" x 30" signs.
- 2 In regard to the intersection of Moutaindale and Spragueville Roads, the Mountaindale Road bridge is undergoing construction. Part of the construction may involve the removal of asphalt from intersection, making it narrow and redesigning it to a T shape intersection, which may make the intersection safer and slow traffic down.
