 - A. Minutes of previous meeting were disseminated and reviewed by all TSC members prior to this meeting.
- IV. New Business
 - A. Ms. Sarah Nottage, Lifespan Risk Manager for Gateway Health, has requested that we petition the State Traffic Safety Commission for a safe way for clients to cross Cedar Swamp Road. She proposes a light that would stop traffic when pedestrians would cross the road by pressing a pedestrian cross button mounted on a pole.
 - B. Frank Smith of 28 Willow Road requests a lower speed limit on Willow Road.
 - C. Ms. Sandra Ariza of 34 Barnes Street requests speed bumps at the beginning and middle of Barnes Street, closest to Route 44.
 - D. Mr. William Andreozzi requests speed limit signs be installed on Austin Avenue near Route 44.
 - E. Mr. Gary Comfort of Tunmore Road, requests better stop sign indicators and a reduction in the speed limit from 25 to 15 mph on Tunmore Road. (see traffic study)
 - F. Mr. Carolann of Julien Street request that Julien Street be posted "No Through Traffic."

G. Chief St. Sauveur requests a letter be sent to the State Traffic Commission requesting removal of trees from the edge of Limerock Road and moving the telephone poles further off the road, as they create a dangerous situation.

H. Principal Laurie Sullivan, of Old County Road School, requests a cost estimate to have a flashing school zone sign installed on Old County Road.

A. Mr. Lou Reo was contacted and instructed to call the station when there is illegal parking on Deerfield Drive near Pleasant View Avenue, for documentation.

B. Ms. Linda Romano, President of Timberland Condo Association, was notified that a stop sign will be installed and a white stop bar line will be painted on Waltham Street at Old County Road, in the spring (weather permitting).

C. Ms. Caestino of 181 Log Road, does not wish to pursue the request to relocate her mailbox through State Politicians.
