

PERMIT FOR DISCHARGE

Pursuant to Chapter 225, Regulation of Illicit Discharges into the Municipal Separate Storm Drainage System of the Smithfield Code of Ordinances, application is hereby made to discharge to the Smithfield MS4 at the location(s) listed above and shown on the attached sketch, and at no other location.

Licensee*, the undersigned, hereby agrees to the following:

1. That the \$50.00 permit fee, made payable to the Town of Smithfield, has been submitted with this permit application.
2. That Licensee shall bear the entire costs for engineering, construction, and maintenance of the private drainage system, including any portion of this drainage system located within the Town's rights-of-way.
3. That the Licensee shall install a backwater control valve on the private system for any direct connections to the Town's MS4.
4. That Licensee shall indemnify and hold the Town free and harmless from all suits and actions caused by the Licensee's acts or failure to act in connection with the engineering, construction, and maintenance of the Licensee's private drainage system and its connection to the Town's MS4.
5. That the construction of the drainage system shall be made in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Town Engineer and subject to compliance with all applicable statutes, ordinances, and rules and regulations of Federal, State or City agencies having the effect of law.
6. That prior to any construction work, the Licensee shall obtain a Road Opening Permit from the Department of Public Works if any work is to take place within a Town street.
7. That the connection to any Town catch basin, manhole, or other portion of the drainage system shall be made by core drill or other approved method.
8. That in the event any portion of the Town drainage system is damaged or destroyed during the construction of the private drain connection the Licensee shall bear the entire cost of engineering and construction or replacement of the damaged facility.
9. That no additions or alterations to the permitted private drainage system will be made without the prior written consent of the Town Engineer.
10. That the private drainage system shall remain the Licensee's property and that the Licensee will be solely responsible for its maintenance and upkeep.
11. That in the event the private drainage system within the Town right-of-way shall at any time interfere with any public use, the Licensee will relocate the private drainage system at the Licensee's expense.
12. That any time the private drainage system discharges pollutants or other objectionable material into the Town MS4 which exceeds applicable water quality standards of the State of Rhode Island, or otherwise misuse the system, or cause a violation of any provisions of the Rhode Island Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (RIPDES) Permit, the Town, by written notice, may terminate this license and have the system removed at the Licensee's expense. In addition, the Licensee shall be liable for any and all penalties as a result of discharges from the Licensee's system.
13. That discharges to the Town MS4 shall be composed entirely of stormwater, non-contaminated groundwater or as permitted under Section 225.6.1 of the Regulation of Illicit Discharges into the Municipal Separate Storm Drainage System of the Smithfield Ordinance. In the event the discharge into the MS4 includes stormwater associated with industrial activity as defined in the Federal regulations, the Licensee shall obtain appropriate Rhode Island Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (RIPDES) permit(s), and shall provide data on the characterization of the constituents, quantity of the effluent and discharge, at the Licensee's expense within one (1) year after the date of connection, and annually thereafter or as the need may arise as determined by the Town Engineer.

14. That Licensee shall provide appropriate best management practices and/or treatment devices for the removal of soil particles, and/or other pollutant(s) in the discharge, to the maximum extent practicable, and such discharge shall meet the basic water quality criteria applicable to all waters, as identified in Chapter 46-12 of the Rhode Island General Laws and the Woonasquatucket River TMDL, at the point of discharge into State waters.
15. That the Town Engineer, or his/her authorized representative, may during reasonable hours and upon notification to Licensee, enter the premises or any building to investigate, measure or test any effluent that is discharged directly or indirectly to the Town's MS4 within the limits of Chapter 225 in the Code of Ordinances.
16. That Licensee will notify the Town Engineer at least 48 hours before commencing construction work at telephone number (401) 233-1041, to arrange for necessary inspectional services.
17. That this agreement shall be made a condition of any subsequent transfer of property ownership.
