Dear Mr. Cleary:

**The purpose of this letter is to notify the public agencies of the Town of Smithfield (Town) and the residents in the area of the Mountaindale Road Bridge that Manafort Brothers Incorporated (MBI) intends on beginning construction on the replacement of on May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2017.**

Please note part of MBI's contract with the Town includes the closure of Mountaindale Road in the immediate vicinity of the existing bridge and a detour will be implemented throughout the duration of construction.

The detour route will include the following: Walter Carey Road, Cedar Swamp Road, Pleasant View Avenue and Spragueville Road. Detour signs will be installed according to the contract drawings prior to the closure of the bridge and removed (or covered) once the bridge has been reopened.

The work outlined below is projected to be completed by November of 2017.

MBI plans on performing the following work, which includes, but is not necessarily limited to the installation of; sheet pile cofferdams, cast-in place concrete abutments, wingwalls and approach slabs, prestressed concrete beam superstructure, approach and bridge sidewalks, crash rail and roadway structure. The work also includes the removal of the existing superstructure, modifications to the existing abutments and the necessary earthwork needed to perform the aforementioned work. Work such as paving, line striping and guardrail installation is to be performed under separate contract with the Town.

Emergency contract information for the MBI representatives assigned to this project is contained in our Health and Safety Plan (HASP), which has been submitted to the Town.
